

## CAP Job Club

A CAP Job Club is designed to equip people with the practical tools necessary to find employment, while rebuilding their confidence and self-esteem.

### Activity

A CAP Job Club gives help and support to the unemployed in your local area, through an eight-week course, community, and one-to-one coaching sessions.



**Time Frames** CAP provides online training for new CAP Job Club managers and coaches. This is a mixture of self-led and interactive learning and will take around 35 hours to complete over 4-6 weeks. Once trained your team should aim to allocate 8-10 hours a week to this ministry which will involve running the course, but also planning and referral building behind the scenes.

### Financial Costs/Contribution

CAP ask churches to make a monthly contribution of £60 to cover the cost of all resources and support.



### Civic Partnership

CAP will help you to build relationships with civic agencies and other local organisations who will send you referrals.



### Project Support

All of the necessary training and resources to lead an effective project is provided. CAP's dedicated team of area managers will then continue to support you on an on-going basis as you continue to run this ministry.

### Physical Resources

You will need a room to hold the sessions where refreshments can be served. The CAP Job Club Manager will also need a computer and access to the internet.



### Human Resources

A CAP Job Club manager and at least one additional CAP Job Club coach will need to be recruited to manage the project. It is also helpful to gather a number of volunteers inside the church to support them.
